With a history of working in catering and having had his own restaurant, Richard was perfectly placed to take up the role of Catering Manager and use his skills to serve the local community.

Our **Community Café** was launched in October 2006 to provide good quality, low cost food in a relaxed and informal environment.

Opening Hours

The Café is open from **8.30am - 3.30pm Monday to Wednesday**, except on the second Wednesday in each month when we run Lunch Club for Senior Citizens.

Twice a month the café is open for Sunday Lunch from 12.30pm.

Normally on the second Sunday of each month there is a two-course guest lunch, which is specifically designed for church members to invite friends who may not normally come to church. Friends are invited to Sunday Lunch at no cost, using a voucher system. You can get vouchers from the Catering Manager.

Normally on the fourth Sunday of each month there is a three-course traditional roast dinner, which is open to all. The Roast Dinner costs £10.00 per head. *A selection of soft drinks is available at both of these meals.*
