Senior Citizens are a significant part of the church family meeting together for Sunday services and attend many weekly activities. To help Senior Citizens continue to grow spiritually and build friendships in their community, we also run a variety of activities designed specifically for them.

Senior Citizens' Services

Our Senior Citizens' Services bring together more than 80 people from across our community to express to God our thanks and praise, to learn more about Him and to express our care for each other.

We hold these services on **six Sunday afternoons each year, from 3.00pm – 4.00pm**. They are advertised locally, well in advance, through posters, hand-bills and our church notice sheet.

At **Senior Citizens' Services** we try to make everything as user-friendly as possible. The varied worship involves listening to musical items, people talking about their faith in God, and singing more traditional hymns. The words to songs are displayed on a large screen, there is a hearing loop system and large print word editions available. We do not take up a collection during the service, however a basket is available at the door for anyone who wishes to give. Each service is followed by tea, coffee and cakes.
