- Filter coffee can be made in advance and kept in the stay warm coffee pots. Please see the instructions for making on the wall above the coffee machine by the hatch. Instant coffee is available when the filter coffee is finished.
- Please start to pour tea/coffee during the final prayer, adding milk to some and leaving a few for those who like their drink without milk. This means that as people leave church the queue for tea and coffee is kept moving. It also keeps exits clear and hopefully encourages people to move into the main foyer.
- For Health and Safety reasons we would prefer that all hot drinks are poured on the kitchen hatch surface which is out of the reach of most toddlers.
